

## Company Safety Plan

Safety Policy Statement: Purus Masonry Restoration is committed to the safety and health of its employees by providing the resources necessary to develop, implement, and administer a safety program for the protection of its employees. All employees of Purus Masonry Restoration have the responsibility to work safely on the job. The safety program is periodically reviewed to ensure and maintain its effectiveness

Supervisors will implement and administer the safety program in their area. Supervisors will conduct a safety meeting each morning with workers on site to discuss any safety issues, hazardous materials and equipment that will be used that day

There will be a qualified, competent person with 30-hr OSHA training on site

Each employee onsite will attend one toolbox/tailgate safety meeting per week

Equipment will be inspected daily for malfunction and maintained in good working order. Workers will be trained and demonstrate competency in using equipment required for the work. Workers are expected to report malfunctioning equipment to the supervisor immediately.

Workers will use PPE on the job including high visibility shirts/jackets/vests, hard hats, steel toe boots, long pants, protective eyewear, dust masks, ear plugs and gloves. 4 inch shirt sleeve minimum

Work areas will be kept clean and neat. Workers will report any unsafe conditions in the work area to the supervisor immediately

All work will terminate in the event of high winds, lightening, heavy rain

Workers will be trained and follow established procedures to prevent falls and mitigate fall hazards. Guardrail systems, harness systems, control zones and other protection will be used in heights of 6 feet or greater

Zero tolerance for life threatening activities. Workers putting themselves at risk by performing a life threatening activity will be removed from the site immediately.



Headsets, earphones or IPod usage is prohibited on site during working hours

All hazardous materials will be marked. Workers will be trained on how to handle an exposure or spill. Safety Data Sheets will be available on site.

First Aid treatment will be readily available on-site. All workers will know where the first aid kit is located. A first aid log will be kept on all injuries and illnesses

Emergency services, medical services and emergency contact phone numbers will be available on-site.

There will be no smoking on the job site unless there is a designated area available that has been assigned for smoking
